



Provision of Winterization Kits to Flood Affected Families in District Kachi/Bolan, Balochistan Project Completion Report

Background:

Balochistan is one of the severely hit areas by (Floods and rains) of the country. Heavy rains and flash floods have hit around 3.6 million people in 33 districts of Balochistan province. 238 people died and more than 200 injured in these floods.

70% of the houses in flood affected areas have fully or partially damaged and people have lost their livestock, daily use items including, utensils, blankets, cloths etc.

Kachi is one of the severely affected districts where the recent flood damaged everything including economic roots of the local communities including livestock, agriculture lands, homes and public buildings.

The PDMA announced an early warning for the locals and especially for those who are living in the tents could be victim of the coming winter rainfalls and severe cold weather conditions. The HOPE organization has been responding flood affected families by provision of food packages and shelter.

During filed visits and community feedback regarding HOPE and MC interventions, community highlighted the issues faced by vulnerable people due to very cold weather in winter and shared that pregnant women, children and old age people are on risk who need urgent assistance of providing blankets, jackets, warm cloths, shawls and shoes etc.

HOPE management with the consent of Muslim charity selected Three villages of District Kachi for interventions of this project as these villages have been badly affected by floods and still majority of the people are living in tents or makeshifts which are vulnerable to cold weather and children are getting ill.

Project Activities:

1. Baseline Need Assessment to Identify and select beneficiaries:

A detailed Assessment was conducted in the focused villages through a pre defined criteria and the data of all potential beneficiaries was collected through beneficiary form provided by Muslim charity.

1.1 Beneficiary Selection process:

The beneficiaries will be selected through the criteria given below:

- 1. Families with fully or partially damaged houses due to flood/rains
- 2. Families who have lost their household items e.g. Blankets, Warm cloths etc.
- 3. Daily waged labour or jobless person
- 4. Families having one or more disabled person
- 5. Families having chronically ill person in the family
- 6. Widow or Women headed families

After detailed assessment the beneficiaries were Finalized/selected with the consent of Village Committee to ensure transparency and accountability.

The database of Beneficiaries was prepared on MS-Excel and shared with Muslim charity for final approval.

2. Distribution of Winterization Kits:

This Project supported 100 most vulnerable families of three focused villages in District Kachi, Balochistan which were badly affected by floods and Moon-Soon rains of last year 2022.

HOPE procurement team had procured required items and prepared Winter Kits according to organization's procurement policy and after packing and branding; these Winter Kits were distributed to selected beneficiaries.

Before distribution, HOPE team finalized the distribution points with the support and participation of Village Committees and all the selected beneficiaries were issued tokens to ensure the selected beneficiaries gets their kits.

Monitoring of Project Activities:

HOPE Monitoring team monitored the assessment and beneficiary selection process as well as distribution process by visiting the selected villages and distribution points.

Village Committee was also involved in monitoring from begging (Assessment) to selection of beneficiaries, implementation and distribution.

Impact:

People who receive Winter Kits are now protected from harsh weather conditions in winter and different seasonal diseases. It will also be an economic support to the beneficiary families as the amount they had to spend on buying Blankets & Warm clothes or Medicines and treatment of illnesses is saved and can be used for their other basic daily needs.
